Suspected robber beaten to death in Edo

A SUSPECTED robber, who was apprehended by his brave victim, has been beaten to death in Benin, the Edo State capital.

The suspected robber gave his name as Peter Osa-herumwen before he died on the way to the hospital.

A cut-to-size double-barrelled gun and two live cartridges were allegedly recovered from him.

It was learnt that three robbers stormed a home at 10pm on Monday on Erediauwa Street, Upper Sakponba, Benin.

have held one of the hoodlums, despite the shots fired at him.

Other members of the gang reportedly fled, leaving Peter behind.

A mob was said to have descended on Peter, beating him unconscious.

Some policemen rescued him.

He died on the way to the hospital.

Police spokesman Stephen Onwochei, a Deputy Superintendent (DSP), could not be reached for comments on the incident.
