Boat mishap: Bodies of policemen found

THE bodies of two policemen from Kogi State have been recovered from the River Niger, six days after the boat they were travelling in capsized near Ibaji in Ibaji Local government.

The victims, Francis Itodo and Sunday Adamu, who were attached to the Ibaji Police Division, were on a special assignment to Uje when their boat capsized.

The late Itodo was the divisional crime officer (DCO) at Ibaji Police Division.

A report by the Deputy Security Officer of the local government, Mr. Joel Ocheje, said 12 persons,

including eight policemen and two representatives of the Ibaji Traditional Council were in the boat.

While others swam to safety, the two policemen reportedly drowned. Their service pistols were recovered.

An eyewitness, who survived the mishap, Mr. Ugbenyo, said the accident happened when they were returning from Uje where they had gone to mediate in a crisis between Irebu and Uchuchu communities.

He said they rescued six policemen.
