

10 killed in Ogun accident

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VICTIM OF A MULTIPLE ACCIDENT ON ABUJA-KADUNA EXPRESSWAY AT ZUBA JUNCTION IN ABUJA ON THURSDAY

AT least 10 persons were killed yesterday in an accident involving two trucks and two commercial vehicles at the Ogunmakin section of the Lagos/Ibadan Expressway in Ogun State.

The two buses rammed into the trucks at about 5a.m, according to Mr Adegoke Adetunji, the FRSC Sector Commander in the state. He said: "a Mazda bus with registration number MAY 152 XA and a Toyota bus with registration number LND 21 XQ, were travelling to Ibadan before they rammed into the trucks.

"We understood that the first truck had broken down in the night and was rammed into by the second truck while the two commercial buses also rammed into the trucks around 5a.m. "Motorists should desist from travelling at night because visibility is limited.

Broken down trucks should always use reflective signs so that oncoming drivers would be able to see them. He asked the public to "always call our number 122 anytime they see any broken down vehicle on the highways." Adetunji said that corpses of victims had been deposited at
