10 arrested for 'killing' Civil Defence member

TEN persons suspected to be petroleum pipeline vandals, have been arrested for allegedly killing a member of the Nigeria Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSCDC), Kwara State Command.

The deceased, Kadiriya Abdulkadir, was reportedly killed during a gun battle with the suspects at Osin

An NSCDC official was injured during the incident.

He was taken to an undisclosed hospital in Ilorin

It was learnt that the suspected vandals, who engaged the security agents in the gun battle, lost one of their colleagues.

Our correspondent gathered that NSCDC men stormed the area, following a tip-off that the suspects were operating there.
