TWO persons were "killed" yesterday in a clash involving members of the National Union of Road Transport Workers (NURTW) in Ikare-Akoko, headquarters of Akoko North East Local Government Area of Ondo State.

Ten persons were injured in the clash, which is believed to be caused by leadership crisis in the branch.

An eye witness said NURTW members in the area were fighting against the continuous stay in office of the chairman.

It was gathered that weapons, including guns and machetes, were freely used during the clash.
