Prosecuting police Sergeant Jimoh Iseghede said the offence was committed on December 9, last yeat at Egan Igando, a Lagos suburb.

The prosecutor alleged that Biobaku died of his wounds.

Iseghede said the offence contravened Section 221 of the Criminal Law of Lagos State, 2011.

Being a murder case, the plea of the accused was not taken.

The case was adjourned till February 16.
