Prophet in prison for friend's death

AN EBUTE META Chief Magistrate's Court in Lagos yesterday remanded Samson Olorunshola, a prophet of a white garment church in prison custody for the alleged murder of his friend.

Chief Magistrate B.O. Ope-Agbe ordered that the ac-

cused be remanded in prison, pending advice from the Office of the Lagos State Director of Public Prosecutions (DPP).

Olorunshola's plea was not taken because the court has no power to try murder cases.

Prosecuting Police Sergeant Jimah Iseghede told the court

that the offence was committed last November 13, at Olorunshola's home on Pearl Estate at Ikota, Lagos.

Iseghede said the accused and the deceased, Taiwo Olajide, 49, had an argument and Olorunshola picked up a iron and hit him on the head with it.

He said the accused had accommodated the deceased in his room.
