## Three dead, others injured in accidents

**T**WO people died yesterday and another injured in an accident on Atan-Ota Road in Ogun State.

The accident, according to the Ado-Odo/Ota Zonal Commander, Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Corps (TRACE), Cdr Adekunle Ajibade, occurred at 6:20am when a Bedford truck with registration number EPE 167 XJ, heading to Agbara, lost control and rammed into some motorcyclists.

He said the driver fled the scene, adding that the victims' remains have been taken for burial and the survivor taken to the General Hospital, Ota.

**2** An unidentified man also died yesterday in an accident at Oke-Maria in Oka-Akoko, Akoko Southwest Local Government Area of Ondo State.

Eyewitness said a trailer lost control and rammed into a filling station.

A source, Chief Lawal Obaalejo, said many people were injured as the town had its market day.

The victims were conveyed in a vehicle to a nearby hospital.
