Female suicide bombers blast 56 to death in IDPs camp

TWO female suicide
bombers have blown
themselves up in an In-
ternally Displaced Persons
(IDPs) camp in Borno State,
killing no fewer than 56 peo-
ple.

Health and rescue officials,
w h o
confirmed Tuesday's bombings,
said 78 people were taken
away injured from the Dikwa
IDPs camp. Dikwa is 85 kilo-
metres outside Maiduguri,
the Borno State capital.

There are about 50,000 IDPs
in the camp, it was learnt.

Officials blamed Boko
Haram for the bombings
which, was not known about
until yesterday because of the
disruption to telephone ser-
vices.

The governor of neighbor-
ing Cameroon's Far North
province said two suicide
bombers believed to have
come from Nigeria also yes-
terday killed 10 people and
injured 40 in a border village.
