

Dispatch rider killed in Lagos accident

A dispatch rider on Monday night died on the Third Mainland Bridge, Lagos, after ramming his motor bike into a stationary truck.

The accident occurred at 7:20pm while the man was returning from Lagos Island.

The unnamed man, until his death, was a dispatch rider at Olowu Spare parts market.

He reportedly rammed his motor bike into the truck marked XR190LSR and died on the spot.

Confirming the accident, the state police command's spokesperson, Dolapo Badmos, a Superintendent of Police (SP), said policemen attached to Oworonshoki division took the man to hospital where he was confirmed dead.

"We learnt that the man has a daughter and has been divorced from his wife. He body has been deposited at the Mainland Hospital Mortuary, Yaba," she said.
