



Man bathed with hot water dies in hospital

In Ebute Metta Chief Magistrate's Court has ordered a 22-year-old student, Mabel Bassey to be remanded in prison custody for an alleged murder.

Bassey, a National Open University (NOUN) student was arraigned before Magistrate Folarin Williams vesterday.

She was said to have poured hot water on her neighbour, Efe Okotie, 38, which allegedly caused his death on July 2.

They both live on 11 Surulere Street, Ojo, Lagos.

It was reported that the deceased advice the defendant to stop her promiscuous lifestyle.



The deceased and the defendant was said to have argued over the matter that generated into a fight.

Thereafter, the defendant was said to have poured hot water on the late Okotie.

Okotie, it was said, reported the matter to the nearest Police Station and went to hospital.

He died six days after the incident due to the severe burns from the hot bath. $\label{eq:control}$

The defendant was arrested and arraigned in court on a charge of murder.

Her plea was not taken.

Prosecuting Sergeant Olatunji Kehinde filed an application that the defendant be remanded in prison custody pending legal advice from DPP office.
