



Ogun State Police Command, Mr. Abimbola Oyeyemi confirmed the incident and informed that Oluwakemi had been arrested and taken into custody at the Obalende Divisional Police Headquarters, Ijebu Ode. Abimbola told journalists that she will be charged for 'wounding or attempted murder.'

Exactly a month earlier, on August 3, a 35-yearold Doris Kanung was alleged to have stabbed her husband, Vincent Kanung, 45, to death at their Alafia Street, residence Mokola, Ibadan, Oyo State. The mother of three was said to have committed the offence at about 11.30 after a heated argument, culminating in her husband's death.

She is currently undergoing trial and has been remanded in custody at the Agodi Prison, in Ibadan.
