Man killed in Ondo

GUNMEN have killed a 50-year old indigene of Oke-Agbe Akoko in Ondo State, who came from Lagos to spend his annual leave with his relatives.

Niyi Aremo told his relatives he wanted to use an Automatic Teller Machine (ATM) in Ikare-Akoko. There was a long queue which forced him to move to Akungba for the transaction. He decided to see his friend in the town.

Sources said after he withdrew the money, his friend volunteered to take him back to Ikare on his bike.

They said he did not return to Okeagbe and did not contact his relatives. They said it was someone who knew him that told his family he had been shot.

He was taken to a private hospital where he died.

His friend was said to have been quizzed by the police in Ikare-Akoko.

The Divisional Police Officer (DPO) could not be reached for comments but a senior officer said the culprits would be arrested.
