

Man 'kills' neighbour with knife

AMAN, Odunayo Idowu, has allegedly killed his neighbour, Ihkey Godwin.

The late Godwin lived at 15, Sete Ayinde Street, Abaranje in Ikotun, Lagos.

But that fateful day, Idowu insisted that his wife would not open the gate for the late Godwin. This led to the argument during which Idowu went into his house, got a knife and allegedly stabbed

Godwin.

Godwin was said to have been rushed to hospital where he died.

A neighbour, who identified herself as Theresa, said she heard noise all through that Friday night but did not know what the matter was.

She described the late Godwin as a peaceful man, saying: "Godwin was not a

trouble maker; it is a pity this happened to him," she said. Area M Idimu Commander, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Austins Akika said investigation is ongoing, adding that Idowu would be taken to the homicide department in Panti for further interrogation and prosecution.
