One dead, 18 injured in Ibadan auto crash

ONE person died yesterday while 18 others were injured in an accident on the Lagos-Ibadan Expressway.

The News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) reports that the accident, which occurred at 8.30 a.m near Guru Maharaji Ji village in Ibadan, the Oyo State capital, involved three vehicles.

Eyewitnesses said a tanker with registration number EPE 88 XT had a brake failure and rammed into a Mazda bus with registration number WWD 772 XA and a Toyota Camry car with registration number LSR 349 SF.

The Oyo State Sector Commander of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC) Mr Yusuf Salami said the accident occurred due to wrong overtaking and mechanical deficiency resulting in a brake failure.

He said a man died, adding that his body had been deposited at the Adeoyo Hospital morgue.

Salami said the 18 persons injured had been taken to Ibadan Central Hospital and University College Hospital (UCH) for treatment.

A statement by the Corps Public Education Officer, Bisi Kazeem, said four children were among the injured while the remaining were adults.
