The suspect said that unknown to him, the same man who advised him to give the woman secret burial reported his action to men of a local vigilance group who caught him while burying his victim.

"I called her to steal her phone and she held me. Because of that, I started beating her. I rushed her with blows. After she stopped breathing, I became afraid.
