

A 40-year-old vulcaniser, Lateef Jimoh has been remanded in prison custody by an Ebute Metta Magistrate's Court for alleged murder.

Jimoh, who hails from Ogun State was alleged to have killed hit a 24-year-old, Okelana Adelaja

Elijah with a plank on his head. Elijah allegedly died shortly the attack.

The deceased, it was learnt was allegedly disturbing the accused in his workshop at Ogunmokon Street, Mushin Lagos.

Then duo then launched into a

scuffle during which Jimoh killed Elijah with a plank at about 8 p.m on July 17, 2017.

(ASP) asked the court to remand the accused in prison custody pending a legal advice from the Directorate of Public Prosecutions (DPP).

He added that the accused had committed offence contrary to Section

222 and punishable under Section 223 of the Criminal Law of Lagos State, 2015.

The presiding magistrate, Mrs A.O Salawu ordered that the accused be remanded in prison custody and adjourned the matter till September 11 for legal advice.

A N Ebute Metta Magistrate's Court has ordered that a Lagos-based Pastor, Stephen Edohe be remanded in prison, for allegedly beating his wife to death.
