

Scrap dealers stab trader to death

TWO scrap dealers, Ibrahim Ma'azu, 22, and Babangida Sule, 22, have been arrested for allegedly killing a trader, Abubakar Suleiman.

They have been slammed with two-count charge of conspiracy and murder.

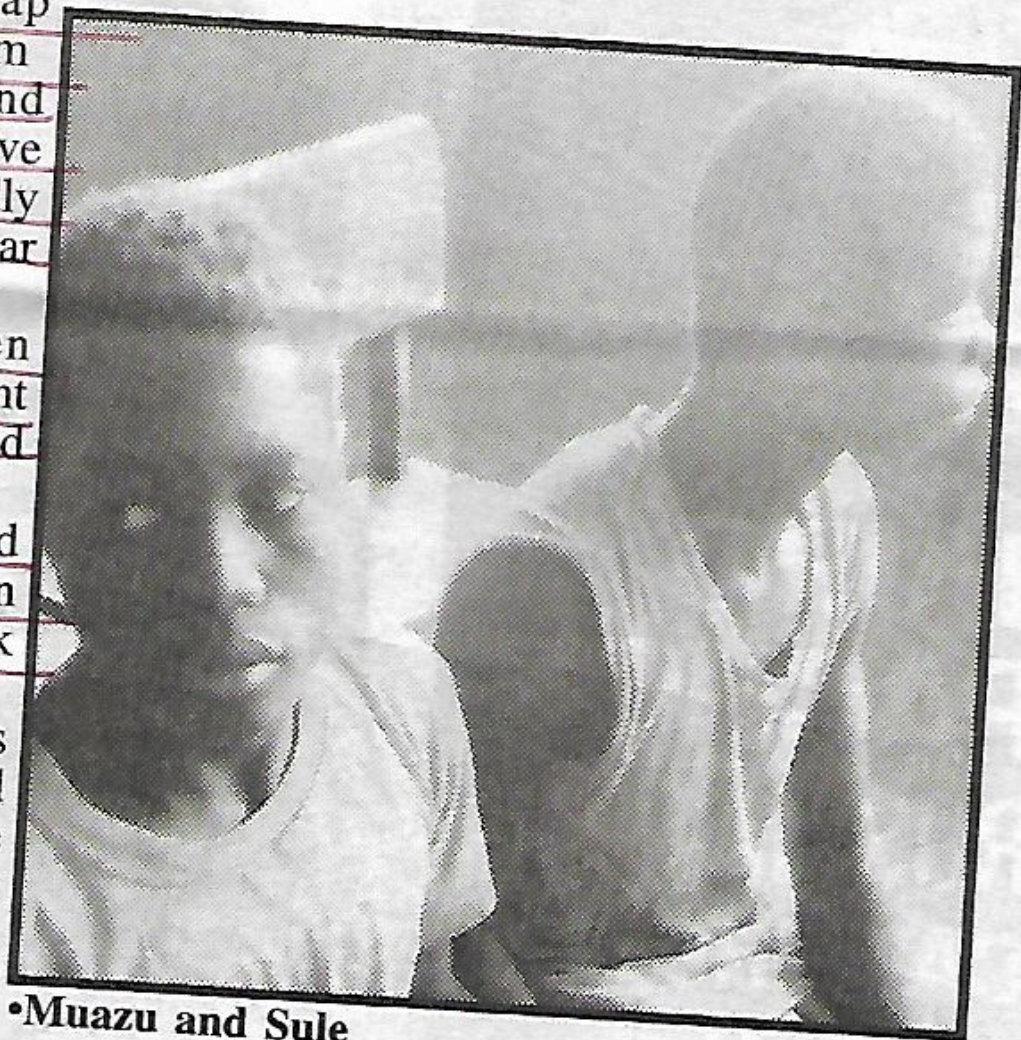
The accused were said to have stabbed Suleiman on the chest and neck with screw drivers.

The deceased, it was learnt had accommodated the duo and one Abdulrahman, now at large in his grocery store based on a daily rent payment.

The accused however refused to pay their rent and a fight broke out between them.

It was during the fight that Abdulrahman allegedly stabbed Suleiman to death by 10 p.m at Itopo Street, Imota, Lagos on July 22.

admitted Babangida to bail in the sum of N100,000 with two sureties.
