10 killed in Gamboru mosque attack

THE National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) has confirmed that 10 persons died in yesterday's attack on a mosque in Gamboru Ngala town, Borno State.

NEMA's Northeast Zonal Coordinator Bashir Garga said many were injured and evacuated to hospitals for treatment.

Garga added that officials of NEMA, SEMA and security operatives cleaned up the scene and assisted victims.

He said that a suicide bomber last night blew himself behind the Dalori Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) camp. He died.

"I can confirm that there was an attack in Gamboru Ngala and 10 people died. The attack was carried out by a male suicide bomber. Officials of NEMA, SEMA, other agencies, the military and police assisted in evacuating the injured to different medical formations that are operating in the town.

"Another suicide bomber

detonated his explosive device yesterday behind the Dalori IDPs camp here in Maiduguri. He alone died.

"I call on the people to be at alert and conscious about strangers who come close to them. My team is working on safety tips to distribute to the public on the new trends of suicide bombings," Garga said.
