

Guard beats suspected thief to death in Ikorodu

A 33-year-old guard Suleiman Sanni, was yesterday arraigned before an Ikeja High Court for allegedly beating a man to death over a stolen motorcycle.

Justice Josephine Oyefeso orderd that he be remanded in Kirikiri Prison and adjourned the case till March 13.

The lead prosecutor, Mrs C. K. Tunji-Carrena, told the court that the defendant committed the offence at 2a.m. on October 8, 2015 at Otunbor Street, Isawo—Owode, Ikorodu, Lagos.

“The defendant, who was the guard of the street caught the 24-year-old deceased, Moses Uche, with a motorcycle which he (Sanni) claimed was stolen.

“Sanni alongside others who are at large beat the deceased with a plank till he was unconscious.
