Police confirm death of suspected kidnapper

HE Police Command in Delta State has confirmed the death of a 57-year-old suspected kidnap kingpin, Anthony Ogbalor.

Command's spokesman Mr Andrew Aniamaka confirmed the development yesterday in a telephone interview

Aniamaka said the deceased, known as "Dracula", died at an undisclosed hospital in Asaba where he was rushed to.

"The information is true, the suspected kidnap king pin, called "Dracula", who has been in our custody, has died in a hospital where he was rushed to due to some complications.

"The cause of his death is yet to be ascertained as we are awaiting autopsy report from the hospital where he was confirmed dead. The deceased has been deposited at the hospital mortuary," Aniamaka said. ch
