

10 die in Ondo road accidents

TEN persons have reportedly died in road accidents on the Ijebu-Ode/Ore Expressway as well as Ibaka Market in Akungba-Akoko.

① It was learnt that the Ijebu-Ode/Ore Expressway accident was a head-on.

The Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) said the accident happened at 1.40 pm and involved a black Mercedes Benz SUV, registered as (Lagos) EPE 144 EW, and a blue Toyota Carina car: (Ondo) KTP 580 RG.

FRSC's Ondo State Sector

Commander Vincent Jack said seven people were involved in the accident.

The FRSC commander said six of them died; the seventh person was injured.

He said the accident was caused by over speeding.

② The Akungba market accident, Jack said, claimed four lives, with two injured.

It was learnt that a truck: (Lagos) LSD 509 XM, had a brake failure and rammed

into a roadside market.

The FRSC chief said the remains of the deceased had been deposited at the morgue of the State Specialist Hospital in Ikare-Akoko.

The injured were also taken to the same hospital for treatment.

He urged motorists to always avoid reckless driving and be mindful of traffic rules and regulations.
