"It was confirmed that the criminals were, setting houses on fire in Igacha, about 4 kilometres away from Kadarko town.

"Troops responded immediately by mobilising to the area to stop the arson and apprehending the perpetrators. The militia, on sighting troops, abandoned their mission and scampered to safety. However, the troops neutralised one of the assailants, while others escaped with injuries.
