

Expectant mum cries out over husband's death

A 34-year-old expectant mother, Mrs. Ekaette Nnonno, whose husband was allegedly killed by the Compliance and Monitoring Team attached to Akwa Ibom State Ministry of Transport and Petroleum Resources, has cried out for help.

Nnonno, a mother of five, implored the government to take over the welfare and education of her children, who were allegedly rendered fatherless by activities of a task force working for the ministry.

The Nation reports the widow's husband, 38-year-old Akaninyene Nnonno, an indigene of Ikot Edung in Ibiono Ibom Local Government, was allegedly killed by task force officials while chasing an Akwa Ibom Transport Corporation (AKTC) driver.

Transport and Petroleum Commissioner Orman Esin described what happened as an accident.

He said: "What happened was an accident involving a driver, members of our team and the victim. We have met the bereaved family and discussed how to assist them. Everyone is satisfied and happy." Police spokesman McDon Odiko promised to confirm any arrest in connection with the accident.
