Container kills two in Ogun

AN Iveco truck carrying a 40-foot container yesterday crushed a commercial motorcycle (*Okada*) rider and his passenger to death on the Lagos-Ibadan Expressway.

The *Nation* learnt that the driver of the truck, marked (Lagos) APP109XQ, lost control on speed, struck against the road's median and overturned on the highway.

The truck and the container

reportedly fell on the *Okada* rider and his passenger.

The Ogun State Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Corps (TRACE) spokesman Babatunde Akinbiyi said two persons - both men - died in the accident.

He said: "The truck lost control due to speeding and overturned on the motorcycle (*Okada*) with a passenger on it. It killed both on the spot.
