A dangerous driver, yesterday morning, knocked down and killed a middle-age electronic seller at Iyana Cele, Owode Ijako in Ifo Local Government of Ogun State. An eyewitness said the victim, whose name was Emmanuel Igbanuwo, lived and sold

electronics at Iyana Cele.

He said Igbanuwo was knocked down by the vehicle while trying to cross the

Lagos/Abeokuta Expressway.

Sources said the 40-year- old father of one was an indigene of Enugu State, and would

soon be taken to his home town for burial.

Ota Divisional Commander of Ogun State Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Corps

(TRACE) Ajibade Adekunle said it was a pity the driver, who refused to stop, ended

Igbanuwo's life in such manner.
