Woman, son arrested over boy's death

Rivers State Police Command has arrested a woman and her son for allegedly stabbing a boy to death.

The Nation learnt that the incident occurred yesterday.

The victim, Chimezie Dike, was allegedly killed for pasting the poster of a Peoples Democratic Party's (PDP's) House of Representatives candidate for PHALGA Constituency 2, Collins Owonda, at 40, Azikiwe Street, Mile 2, Diobu, Port Harcourt.

Sources said the deceased was contracted to paste the posters in the neighbourhood.

An eyewitness, simply identified as Emmanuel, said there an argument between the suspects and victim while he was pasting the posters, resulting in a fight and murder.

Police spokesman Nnamdi Omoni, a Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP), confirmed the incident. He said the suspects have been arrested and will be arraigned after investigation.
