Two held for allegedly killing artisan














The deceased was declared missing last December 19.

The names of the suspects were given as Ebuka and Godwin.

The remains of Monday, aged 28, were recovered inside a bush at Uteh community in Ikpoba-Okha Local Government.

It was learnt that the suspects got the victim's number and called him that they had a job for him.

When the victim got to the location, they killed him after torturing him to give them the pin of his ATM card.

The bush where they killed the victim was set ablaze after which the suspects withdrew over N1million from the victim's account and fled to Anambra State.

Ebuka, who led policemen to the scene where the remains of the victim were recovered, pleaded to be forgiven, saying they selected the location for easy operation.

Police spokesman Chidi Nwabuzor urged the public to be wary of those who called them for business transaction.
