
Two dead, several injured in multiple accidents







The two persons, a man and a woman, suspected to be traders along the expressway were killed, while the injured are passengers of the vehicles.

The accident occurred around 6:33pm when the brake of an Iveco truck with registration number GZA379XA, travelling from Sango in Ogun State to Lagos State failed. The vehicle rammed into other 12 vehicles and one motorcycle.

The Ota Unit Commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Kunle Oguntoyinbo and Ota Divisional Commander of Ogun State Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Corps (TRACE), Adekunle Ariyo Ajibade, who confirmed the accident, said the crash occurred around 6:33pm when the truck's brake failed and it rammed into other vehicles.

They said the other vehicles involved were: black Toyota Corolla FsT136CX, yellow Volkswagen bus FST623Xc, gold colour Hyundai car KRD640AX, yellow colour tricycle TTN103XVY, red Toyota Corolla FST293FT, yellow Volkswagen bus KTU917XP, blue Volkswagen bus KRU998AH, blue Toyota Camry KTU521BL, yellow Volkswagen bus KRD743XT, blue Mazda 626 AKD254EF, yellow Volkswagen bus FST818XA and a Boxer bike, not registered.
