The defendant was said to have threatened that whoever refused to accept his religion would either be stabbed or have his property damaged.

The prosecutor alleged that in the process, the defendant maliciously damaged a Toyota Camry marked LND 568 FM Lagos and a Honda saloon car with number plate GGE 478 AM Lagos.

She said in the process, the defendant stabbed one Ojo, 27, whose surname was yet to be provided, to death, adding that the deceased was stabbed in the chest with a
