Suspected motorcycle snatchers kill 33-year-old motorcyclist in Jigawa

SUSPECTED motorcycle snatchers on Friday allegedly killed a 33-year-old motorcyclist in Dutse Local Government Area of Jigawa, the Police have said.

SP Abdu Jinjiri, the

Spokesman, Jigawa Police Command told the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) on Friday in Dutse that the incident occurred at about 8.30 a.m.

Jinjiri said the deceased, Musa Usaini, a resident of

Jigawa Habiba village was attacked while on his motorcycle by suspected motorcycle snatchers.

He explained that the suspects allegedly hit the deceased with a club on his head, he was suspected to have died on the spot.

"Today (Friday), at about 8.30 a.m., one Ibrahim Isah aged 30 of Jigawa Habiba by Dutse International Airport reported to the police that one Musa Usaini of same address was attacked on his motorcycle.
