

Mother, daughter die in Delta fire

A mother and daughter, simply identified as Carol and Favour, have died from a fire which razed down a building in Eku, Ethiope East Local Government of Delta State.

The fire was allegedly caused by adulterated kerosene.

Three others were injured and properties, including a commercial shop and a nearby caravan.


Details of the inferno were still sketchy as at last night, but a witness said the fire started when Carol, a kerosene dealer, was attending to a customer and the shop caught fire which spread and then the building went ablaze.

Carol died instantly while her daughter, Favour, died on her way to the hospital.

Commissioner of Police Adeyinka Adeleke said only one person died.

He said: "Only one person died. The fire started from kerosene and petrol in the house. A woman was selling the adulterated kerosene."
