
Expectant woman, motorcyclist killed in Osun crash



Two persons, one of them an expectant woman, were Saturday night killed in a ghastly auto crash near Lameco Petrol Station in Osogbo, the Osun State capital.

The crash, which happened around 10pm, involved two vehicles, a tipper truck, a Nissan Primera vehicle and a motorcycle.

The body of the unidentified commercial motorcyclist was badly mutilated while his lady-passenger's legs were crushed.

It was gathered that the driver of the tipper marked FNN 364 XA (Osun) coming from the Iwo axis of Osogbo East By-pass lost control of his truck due to brake failure while approaching the petrol station and ran over the motorcyclist and his passenger coming from Ilobu Road direction.

The truck also reportedly hit a Nissan Primera with registration number EJG 581AA (Osun) and seriously injured the driver, who was the sole occupant of the vehicle.

The driver of the vehicle was promptly taken to hospital by men of the Osun State-owned ambulance service while the remains of the victims of the accident have been taken to the mortuary.

The police and Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) had a hectic time controlling vehicular movement at the scene of the accident.
