Gunmen kill 28 in Zamfara

GUNMEN have killed 28 people in Zamfara State and injured several others.

During their attacks at Babban Rafi village in Gummi Local Government on Tuesday and Wednesday nights, the hoodlums murdered 28 people.

A resident told The Nation that the gunmen stormed the village on

Tuesday and went from house to maiming and killing house occupants.

He said in the operation, the hoodlums killed 21 people, adding that the absence of the police and soldiers made their attack to be successful.

"As the bodies were being buried, the bandits struck again on Wednesday night, killing seven persons," he said.

The resident appealed to the government to provide security.

Police spokesman Shehu Muhammad said according to reports, 14 people were confirmed dead in the attack.
