

Akeredolu's aide narrates how cousin was killed by herdsmen

SENIOR Special Assistant on New Media to Governor Oluwarotimi Akeredolu, Mr. Gani Muhammed Ajowa, has narrated how his cousin, Dayo Ibiye, was killed by suspected herdsmen.

Gani said his 48 years old cousin was killed yesterday in his farm at Ajowa Akoko in Akoko North West Local Government Area.

He stated that the suspected herdsmen and his late cousin

■ Osagie OTABOR, Akure ■ had an altercation when the herdsmen grazed on farm-lands in the area.

He said the herders insisted on grazing on his farm by insisting that the crops belonged to "everyone".

According to him, "the herdsmen came back today (yesterday) and attacked him with different weapons. But when they realised that he was not affected, they strangled him to death."
