Two die, three injured in Lagos-Ibadan road crash

TWO truck attendants were reported dead while three others sustained various degrees of injuries in an accident involving two trucks and a motorcycle at Nasfat U-turn on Lagos-Ibadan Expressway.

Ogun Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Corps (TRACE) Divisional Commander in Mowe/Ibafo, Ojuoro Olusola, told the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) that the accident occurred at about 10.02 a.m. on Wednesday.

Olusola explained that a Homo truck with no plate

number, inbound Lagos, was negotiating a turning at Nasfat U-turn when it collided with a DAF truck that was at top speed.

He said that two trucks, a motorcycle and five persons were involved in the accident that led to the death of the two motor boys, while the two drivers and motorcyclist, sustained various degrees of injuries.

"The bodies of the two motor boys were still trapped in the crash, while the survivors were taken to an undisclosed hospital," he said.
