

Police spokesman Odiko Macdon confirmed the incident, adding that an investigation has begun.

Herders killed one person and abducted six in Aguamade community in Isi-Uzo council area of Enugu State.

One of the abductees was a woman.

The incident came barely two weeks after another community, Mgbuji in the same area was attacked and four natives killed by suspected herders.

Village sources said the latest incident happened on Wednesday.

The gunmen demanded N10 million for the abductees, The Nation learnt.

The villagers have raised N230,000 which they paid to the kidnappers on Friday.

Police spokesman Daniel Ndukwe said he was not briefed on the incident.
