Bandits kill seven in Kaduna LGAs

RMED bandits have killed seven persons within the last /2 hours in Chikun, Kajuru and Giwa local government areas of Kaduna State.

The abductors of 13 persons, including two minors in Udawa Chikun Local Government Area of the state, are demanding N25 million as ransom from the family of the kidnap victims.

Kaduna State Commissioner for Internal Security and Home Affairs, Samuel Aruwan, said security agencies reported the killings to the state government on Saturday.

A community leader, Alhaji Umaru Udawa, told journalists that seven women, four boys and two minors were kidnapped.

In a statement issued Saturday evening, the commissioner said; "According to the security agencies, the outskirts of Tsohon Gayan General Area of Chikun LGA
