Five prospective Corps members die in Abuja accident

statement yesterday.

The statement issued by Director, Press and Public Relations Mrs Adenike Adeyemi did not say where the prospective Corps members were going when the accident happened yesterday.

The statement reads: "It is with a deep sense of sorrow that the Director-General, management and the entire NYSC family commiserate with the families of five prospective Corps members that lost their lives in a ghastly motor accident about 2am on Wednesday, July 28, along Abaji/ Kwali Expressway.

In Niger, a reckless driver hit three SS1 students of the Government Secondary School Field Base Suleja, killing them.

The students were walking home after school on Monday when the speeding driver ran into them, it was said.

Eight other students sus-

tained injuries.

The driver, also injured, is being treated under police watch.

Commissioner of Education Hajiya Hannatu Jibrin Salihu described the incident as painful and tragic.
