

Two varsity students die in Ogun after drinking Sniper

TWO students of Tai Solarin University of Education (TASUED), Ijagun, Ogun State have died after accidentally ingesting Sniper, an insecticide.

The names of the students were not ascertained but they were said to be a male and female.

The Nation gathered that the lady is a 200-level student of Library and Information while the male is also a 200 level student, in Mathematics

department.

The lady had gone to the male student's room on Sunday evening but when she tarried in returning to her room hours after, her anxious roommate decided to check on her at the male's hostel.

It was learnt that on getting there, the worried

roommate saw her body on the floor while the male student was unconscious.

Both were rushed to the university health centre where a doctor confirmed the female student dead.

The male student was removed to Olabisi Onabanjo University Teaching Hospital, and later to Babcock University Teaching Hospital, where he died, a source said.

TASUED spokesperson

Mrs Odubela Ayotunde confirmed the death of the female student and commiserated with the family.

She said, "We are just trying to do some cross-checking. The lady was the one that died in the male's hostel in the night. The male student is still on admission at the hospital. We commiserate with the family of the deceased while we await report of what actually transpired."
