

How we killed Sen. Na Allah's son, by suspects

POLICE IN Kaduna yesterday paraded suspects in the killing of Captain Abdulkarim Bala Na-Allah, son of Senator Bala Na-Allah.

The pilot was killed in his Malali residence two weeks ago.

Bashir Muhammad, 23, and Nasiru Salisu, 27, were presented before journalists while a third suspect identified as Usman DanKano, was reportedly on the run.

Bashir Muhammad claimed he did not know the deceased, adding that they only came to steal his car.

"I did not know the deceased; One day, we were passing in front of his house, three of us including Nasiru, me and Usman DanKano when we saw a car parked inside the house.

"DanKano casually said we will come and pick the car from the house. The next day while it was raining, we gained access into

the vicinity, climbed the roof and removed the nails of the roofing sheets.

"When we got inside the house, Nasiru and I opened the door for Usman who was holding a torch, whose

light attracted the attention of the deceased. Immediately he saw us, he picked something from under his bed and started struggling with Nasiru.

"During the struggle, he fell down and we used a rope for hanging clothes to tie him and he never spoke

again. We picked up the car keys and left."

Police spokesman Muhammad Jalige said the suspects have confessed to the crime, adding that the vehicle was sold in Niger Republic for N1 million with the proceed shared amongst them.

Jalige said the hunt for the third suspect was on.
