MOB in Kaduna has lynched a man along with his wife and their son for alleged collaboration with bandits.

Commissioner for Internal Security and Home Affairs Samuel Aruwan confirmed the incident in a statement yesterday, citing a security report.

He said Abdullahi Mohammed Gobirawa, his wife Binta and son Hassan were killed on Monday in the Zangon Aya area of Igabi council.

Aruwan said after killing the three, the mob set their home ablaze in response to

their suspected collaboration with bandits.

"After killing the trio, the mob looted and burnt their home,"Aruwan said, adding that investigation into the incident had begun. Aruwan said Governor Nasir El-Rufai expressed sadness and deep worry over the violent action of the mob, and strongly condemned the extra-judicial killings.

"He stressed that lawful means alone should be adopted in confronting suspicions of criminality, as the destructive practice of self-help would only result in greater harm.

"The governor directed security agencies to conduct thorough investigation into the incident, and urged citizens to maintain order. He cautioned against stereotyping of any sort," Aruwan said.
