Yahoo boys dump 20-year-old's body on bridge

POLICE in Ogun State have arrested four suspected internet fraudsters also known as *Yahoo boys* in connection with the murder of one Alexander Uzoma.

Uzoma, 20, was initially said to be missing but later said to have died at the hands of the suspects, Babatunde Owoseni, Azeez Oyebanji, Ayobami Adesina and Balogun Sulaiman, who allegedly dumped his body on Kuto Bridge in Abeokuta.

The body was later removed by public health workers and buried.

The suspects were arrested after Uzoma's

mother, Ogechi Alexander, complained at Adigbe divisional police headquarters that her son left home on November 20, 2021 but did not return.

The woman also said the deceased told her that he was going to visit some of his friends whom she did not know.

After some days, the commissioner of police, Lanre Bankole, directed that the case be transferred to State Criminal Investigation and Intelligence Department (SCIID).

Detectives first arrested Owoseni, who led the police to the other three suspects.

Police spokesman Abimbola Oyeyemi confirmed the incident yesterday in a statement, adding that the suspects claimed the 20-year-old visited them to learn how to defraud people using the internet.

Oyeyemi added that the suspects further said all five of them ate together and took a substance called Colorado, after which they fell asleep but only Uzoma did not wake up.

The suspects later evacuated the body to the bridge and left it there, but police said there were marks on the body of the deceased, suggesting violence on the deceased before he died.
