Driver kills woman in Anambra

woman was yesterday crushed to death, while two others were seriously injured in a lone crash along Igboukwu-Oraifite road in Anambra State.

The crash, which occurred in front of St John Catholic Church around 9:15 am, involved an ash Toyota Camry with registration number ENU63AR.

An eyewitness said the speeding driver lost control and rammed into three pedestrians in front of the church, killing the woman on the spot.

Confirming the incident, the Sector Commander, Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Adeoye Irelewuyi, attributed the crash to excessive speed and loss of control.

He sympathised with the bereaved family, warning the motoring public to desist from speeding. He said they should maintain a safe Two injured

speed limit.

Said he: "A fatal road traffic crash occurred at St John Catholic Church, by Igboukwu-Oraifite road, yesterday at about .09:15hrs.

"The lone crash involved an Ash Toyota Camry (private) with registration number ENU63AR.

"Ten people comprising three men and seven women were involved in the crash. One woman was killed, while two women were injured.

"The injured victims were conveyed to Nnewi Teaching Hospital where one woman was confirmed dead by the doctor on duty.

"The FRSC rescue team on ground managed traffic and ensured that the obstruction caused was cleared."
