Ondo Prophetess docked for alleged murder

Development Church of Christ, IgbaraOke, Ifedore Local Government Area,
Ondo State, Prophetess Serah Abuloye, has
been docked for alleged murder of a member
of her church.

Abuloye was alleged to have killed and dumped one 37 years old Adefunke Aselogbon in a bush behind her church on January 6, 2022.

An Akure Magistrate's Court yesterday ordered that the 49-year-old prophetess be

remanded in police custody.

Police prosecutor, Obalasa Ajiboye, informed the court that the defendant committed the offence at about 4 am along Isarun Road, Igbara-Oke in the Ondo State Magisterial District.

Abuloye was arraigned on two-count

charge of conspiracy and murder.

Both offences, according to Ajiboye, were contrary to and punishable under Section 324 and 319(1) of the Criminal Code, Cap. 37, Vol. 1, Laws of Ondo State of Nigeria, 2006.

The plea of the accused was not taken.

Ajiboye, in an oral application, urged the court to remand the defendant in correctional centre's custody pending the outcome of advice from the Director of Public Prosecutions (DPP).

Counsel to the defendant, Mrs Ola Adedire, did not oppose the prosecutor's

application.

Presiding Magistrate, Damilola Sekoni, ordered the remand of the defendant in police custody and adjourned the case till February 18, 2022 for ruling on remand application.
