Two held over biker's murder in Ogun

victim, reported that his 25year-old son, Yusuf Bihari, left home with his motorcycle a day before he was found dead in an uncompleted building at Araromi village via llogbo town.

"He reported that his motorcycle was nowhere to be found.

"Upon the report, the Divisional Police Officer (DPO), Sango-Ota Division, SP Saleh Dahiru, detailed his detectives to the scene where the corpse was evacuated and handed over to the family," Oyeyemi said.
