

NYSC probes death of missing corps member

The management of the National Youth Service Corps (NYSC) has commenced investigation into the death of a missing corps member, Stephanie Se-Ember Terungwa.

The family of the fair-complexioned lady had declared her missing in a notice shared on social media.

Stephanie, who was declared missing in Abuja on April 14, was later found dead with her body mutilated.

A statement issued by the NYSC Director of Press and Public Relations, Mr Eddy Megwa, said: “The attention of NYSC management has been drawn to the pictures making the rounds in the social media of a missing corps member deployed to the Federal Capital Territory, Abuja.

“The corpse was found wearing the NYSC khaki trouser with the face defaced beyond recognition.

“On account of this, management reported the discovery to relevant security agencies to help identify the body.

“It was later confirmed that the remains was that of a missing corps member, Stephanie Se-Ember Terungwa, with State Code Number FC/21B/5807.

“Investigations are, however, currently ongoing to unravel the identity of the perpetrators of the dastardly act in order to bring them to justice.”
