

Bayelsa CP's manhunt for suspects in cult killing

A man identified simply as Friday has been killed in a cult clash in Yenagoa, the Bayelsa State capital.

Friday was killed yesterday in the Aritalin area of the city where cult members engaged one another in a free-for-all.

It was unclear whether the deceased was part of the cult gang or was caught in the crossfire.

Commissioner of Police Ben Nebolisa Okolo ordered operatives to fish out those who murdered Friday, said to be a mechanic.

Spokesman for the command, Asinim Butswat, said the police on July 25, 2022, at about 1300 hours, responded to a distress call of a cult clash in the area.

He said riot policemen on arrival at the scene discovered the mechanic's body whose surname could not be ascertained.

He said investigation was ongoing.
