Gunmen kill nine, injure 20 in Plateau

UNMEN have killed nine persons and inured 20 in the Ser community of Bokkos council of Plateau State.

A Fulani militia was blamed for the attack, which took place

on Tuesday night.

The locals said the attackers burnt over 30 houses, including harvested crops, cars, and motorcycles, among others.

Mr Sylvester Wallangko, who represents Bokkos in the state House of Assembly, re-

From Kolade Adeyemi Jos portedly lost relatives and property in the attack.

Wallangko called for more synergy between the locals and security agencies in order to curb the attacks.

The community has buried those killed in the attack in a mass grave, with Wallangko in tears as the bodies were lowered into the ground yesterday.

Police were yet to issue a statement on the attack as The Nation went to press.
