

Again, troops hit bandits in Kaduna

Troops of the Nigerian Army have neutralised several bandits during clearance operations in bandits' enclaves around Idasu, Fatika and Makera forests in Giwa Local Government Area of Kaduna state.

A statement signed by the Commissioner for Internal Security and Home Affairs, Mr Samuel Aruwan, said a military operational feedback to Kaduna state government reported that "many bandits have been confirmed neutralised so far, while others fled with gunshot injuries to the Hayin Siddi area around the interstate boundaries.
